## **TWELVE MEN IN ALL**

*Acts 19:1-10*

As the Apostle Paul continued on his third missionary journey, he made his way back to Ephesus via the upper country of what is part of modern day Turkey. Ephesus was strategically located, distinguished by a large, sheltered harbor, allowing it to become a major communication hub in the Roman Empire. Sea traffic from the Aegean sea to the west, the Dardanelles to the north, and Palestine to the east, stopped at Ephesus.

It was in this setting that Paul would invest two years of his time. The opening verses of this chapter describe Paul's encounter with twelve men who were very religious, but lacked the reality of a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. There was a missing ingredient to their lives, and what is fascinating is that they did not know what (or who) was missing. This is true as well for many in our circle of relationships. Let's explore this passage together, and consider how to bring the missing ingredient to those who need Jesus.
