#### OF TIME AND ETERNITY

Ecclesiastes 3:1-15

The beginning of a year presents us with a great opportunity to reflect upon time and how it relates to the sovereign plan of God. As we review 2020, we are able to measure our use of time in relationship to eternity. Was time wasted or invested? Did we pursue matters of primary significance or settle for matters of secondary concern? How did the temporal relate to the eternal?

The focal point of Ecclesiastes 3:1-15 is verse 11, where we are told of God...

He has made everything beautiful in its time. Also, he has put eternity into man's heart, yet so that he cannot find out what God has done from the beginning to the end.

Let's explore this extraordinary passage together, as we seek to apply these changeless truths to our changing times.
