THE SHAPING OF LEADERS, PART 2

Acts 20:25-31

It was a farewell address never to be forgotten. Having completed a thirty mile trek from Ephesus to Miletus, the church leadership from Ephesus were given the great privilege of being taught by the Apostle Paul one last time, before he would depart from their midst. As we noted last week, Paul developed sound, biblically-based leadership essentials for these men to undertake.

In J. Oswald Sanders' book entitled *Spiritual Leadership*, he described these biblically-based leaders as those who years earlier dedicated themselves to practice the discipline of seeking first the kingdom of God. Then, as that person matures, God confers a leadership role, and the Spirit of God goes to work through that person. This, of course, was true of Paul. Let's examine Acts 20:25-31 carefully, as we seek to implement biblically-based leadership principles within and through our congregation.
