THE SHORELINE SEND-OFF

Acts 20:32-38

As we consider the Apostle Paul's last words to the leaders from the church in Ephesus, our minds are enlightened by the thoughts of J. Oswald Sanders. In the book *Spiritual Leadership*, Sanders ponders the need for reproducing leaders as he writes these words:

Leadership training cannot be done on a mass scale. It requires patient, careful instruction and prayerful, personal guidance over a considerable time. Disciples are not manufactured wholesale. They are produced one by one, because someone has taken the pains to discipline, to instruct and enlighten, to nurture and train one that is younger.

This was the manner by which the Apostle Paul equipped the elders on the shoreline of Miletus for biblically-based leadership. Let's apply the lessons taught to our lives today.
