Dr. Gary Hylander Acts Series

READY TO MOVE FORWARD

Acts 21:1-16

The pursuit of God's will should be the supreme priority of every Christian. When teaching his disciples to pray, our Lord Jesus Christ used the words "Your kingdom come, *your will* be done, on earth as it is in heaven" (Matthew 6:10). This does not mean that pursuing the will of God is the equivalent of experiencing tranquility in life. When our Lord was in the Garden of Gethsemane, he prayed "My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, *not as I will*, *but as you will*." (Matthew 26:39)

As we pursue the will of God, it is also important to discern the ways of God. Our sovereign God may chose various ways to fulfill his will. As God would remind us "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways *my ways*, declares the LORD (Isaiah 55:8). In today's passage, we will note how the Apostle Paul pursued God's will while accepting God's ways, no matter how difficult they might be.
