LORD OF THE NATIONS

Psalm 2

Psalm 1 and 2, taken together, are the introduction to the following 148 psalms. A good introduction helps the reader understand the key issues which will be addressed at length later.

Psalm 1 clearly sets forth the contrast between those who celebrate *God's Word* and take it to heart, versus those who want to rule their own lives, rejecting *God's Torah*. At issue is *God's Word*: those who love it are righteous; those who reject it are unrighteous. *God's Word* will be the theme of many of the following 148 psalms.

Psalm 2 shows the contrast of those who celebrate *God's Son* (represented immediately by King David), versus those who only want to serve other kings. At issue is *God's promise and God's Messiah*: those who love him and surrender their lives to him are righteous; those who resist and reject him are unrighteous. *God's authority in setting up an earthly dynasty leading to Jesus Christ* will be the theme of many of the following 148 psalms.

Our study of this psalm will inform the mindset, tone and actions as those blessed to take refuge in the beautiful name of Jesus Christ, *God's Messiah*, reigning eternally and perfectly over *God's world*.
