Book One

THE HEARING WE SEEK

Psalm 5

In prior weeks, we have viewed Psalms 1 and 2 as our gateway into the Psalms. We have noted that Psalm 1 is a Torah Psalm and Psalm 2 is a Messianic Psalm. As we venture into Book One of the Psalms, it becomes apparent that David faces continuous conflict in his role as King of Israel. As we read through Book One, we are struck by the intensity of the conflict between *the righteous* and *the wicked*. David, as representative of the Messianic line leading to Jesus Christ, finds himself opposed by an anti-messianic line (antichrist line) which seeks to thwart God's promised plan of redemption.

Psalm 5 develops our understanding of this battle, and gives us insight as to how David addressed such strife. The major theme in Psalm 5 is *prayer*, and these verses provide us with needed perspective as to how we should pray in distressing times.
