Death – n.

- 1) the event of dying or departure from life;**
- 2) the permanent end of all life functions in an organism or part of an organism;**
- 3) the end of life;**
- 4) the time when something ends;**
- 5) a final state;**

Death by definition:

1. Spiritual Death is the **spiritual** separation of the sinner from God (*Psalm 51:5; Romans 3:23; 5:12; 6:23*)
2. Physical Death is the **temporary** separation of the body from the soul and spirit (*John 19:30*)
3. Second Death is the **eternal** separation of the sinner from God (*Revelation 20:11-15*)

Observations about death:

1. Death is our **enemy** (*1 Corinthians 15:24-26*); not the ultimate healing! Death was contrary to God's intentions.
2. Death will be **destroyed** (*1 Corinthians 15:50-57; Revelation 20:14a; 21:4*) by JESUS (*Hebrews 2:14, 15*)!
3. Death is a **doorway**

Are the dead present with us now?

Can they see what we are doing?

2) What happens when we die?



Scripture does not teach:

- The dead **see** us
- The dead **surround** us with their presence
- The dead can **communicate** with us in séances, occult activities or spiritism. These practices are severely condemned in Scripture (*Deuteronomy 18:9-13; 20-22*)
- The virgin **Mary** or other dead saints pray for us
- The dead need our **prayers**
- The dead can be **reincarnated**
