## **FROM EVERLASTING TO EVERLASTING**

### *Psalm 90*

As we transition from Book 3 to Book 4 in the Psalms, a change in tone becomes apparent to us. In Book 3, the psalmists reviewed the various international conflicts endured by the Jewish people. Invasion after invasion is described in poetic form, with David's throne seemingly lying in the dust of destruction in Psalm 89. However, in Book 4, the opening verse in Psalm 90 informs us that the Lord is our dwelling place, and that our God is eternal. Hope is restored in these opening verses.

The superscription informs us that Psalm 90 is a prayer of Moses. In all likelihood, this is the earliest of the psalms. We will want to connect what is described in Psalm 90 with the trials endured by Moses as he led the Israelites through the wilderness. Reflect upon Numbers 20:10, and ponder how the event described there shapes Moses' words. Connect Deuteronomy 32 and 33 to various verses in Psalm 90. As we do so, we will better understand God's view of time and eternity. Welcome to Book 4!
